

HOME DEFENSE ROOM CLEARING & BUILDING SEARCHES

Class size is limited to 14 participants

The *Basic Sheepdog Academy* and *Stop the Bleed* are recommended by not required to attend this course. This is a non-shooting course.

Course Information

This course is designed as a basic introduction level course of instruction. No prior tactical training is required. This is a nonshooting course that will focus mainly on safety, equipment and tactics. Students will have the opportunity to build the skills necessary for home and business room clearing and building searches under the close supervision of trained instructors.

The information provided in this course has been specifically designed to assist civilians in the defense of their home, business or other related buildings.

This course will include lecture and hands on training time. Topics include combat mindset, threat assessment, firearm and ammo selection and tactical equipment selection. Individual and group room clearing and building searches – slicing the pie, group stacking and movement, deliberate and dynamic entry, cross and loop door way entries, ruse/diversion tactics.

Student Equipment & Requirements

SAFETY IS ALWAYS FIRST

- BE ON TIME: Registration at 9:45 AM. Course will start at 10:00 AM
- Course Fee: To be determined: Payment due at the time of the course (cash or personal check). Funds collected are used to cover the cost of classroom equipment and other course related expenses.
- Students must be over the age of 21 and not be restricted by Federal or State law from owning or possessing a firearm. A current concealed handgun license is highly recommended but not required. Any questions please contact the course instructor.
- <u>This is an interactive and physical course</u>. There will be some lecture but most of the course will require you to participate in individual and group drills and exercises. There will be some light to medium levels of physical activities such as walking, bending, and twisting associated with this course. This is not a spectator course.

- Please wear proper clothing and foot wear for a light physical active course.
 - $\circ~$ No sandals, open toe shoes, shorts or tank tops.
- This is a non-shooting course. After the lecture section there will be **NO loaded** firearms, ammo or magazines in the training area. ALL firearms will be cleared and checked by three inspectors and red taped for the remainder of the course. <u>A safety briefing will be conducted at the start of the course</u>.
- Bring your primary home defense or carry handgun with a secure holster and sturdy belt. You may also bring your home defense carbine, rifle or shotgun. We will be inside a building so the shorter the barrel length the better for this type of training. <u>ALL firearms brought to the class must be legal to possess under</u> <u>Federal and State law.</u>
- Bring the flashlight you use for home security. If you have body armor that you use for home defense please bring it.
- No consumption of alcohol or other intoxicants prior to the course. Anyone considered under the influence will be dismissed from the course.
- Please do not bring young children to the course. This is an invitation course for vetted adult students only.
- No cameras or recording devices unless approved by the Instructor.
- We suggest you bring your own water/drinks and snacks. There will be several breaks during the day. There will be a 20 minute lunch. We suggest you bring a brown bag lunch since we are not near any commercial food services.
